Case-1 (When MHP site is allotted by PEDA)

Case forward to this office through PEDA office with their site allotment letter, recommendation letter along with Detail project report (DPR).

This office forward case to field offices for their comments/ field data and their recommendation.

After scrutinizing the field data and DPR, if the proposal fit in-principal then the DPR is vetted by this office and same is conveyed to all parties for further perusal.

A tripartite agreement between PEDA, Entity & Water resources department is signed.

At final stage DPR is approved by PEDA.

Case-2 (When site is self identified)

Case forward to this office through PEDA along with preliminary proposal.

For preliminary examination case is forward to field office to check the feasibility of the project.

If the case is found feasible from concerned field office and this office, DPR should submit to this office through PEDA office along with their recommendation.

This office forward case to field offices for their comments/ field data and recommendation.

After scrutinizing the field data and DPR, if the proposal fit in-principal then the DPR is vetted by this office and same is conveyed to all parties for further perusal.

A tripartite agreement between PEDA, Entity & Water resources department is signed.

At final stage DPR is approved by PEDA.
